

Carpet Cleaning Checklist

- 1. Pre-Inspection of Carpets: Assessing carpet fiber, condition, and stains before cleaning.
- 2. Pre-Vacuuming: Removing loose soil and debris before deep cleaning.
- 3. Stain Pre-Treatment: Applying cleaning agents to treat spots and stains before general cleaning.
- 4. Hot Water Extraction (Steam Cleaning): Deep cleaning with hot water and cleaning solution injected and extracted.
- 5. Dry Carpet Cleaning: Low-moisture cleaning for delicate carpets.
- 6. Carpet Shampooing: Agitating fibers with foaming shampoo solution to loosen grime.
- 7. Pet Stain & Odour Removal: Eliminating pet urine stains and smells using enzyme-based solutions.
- 8. Sanitisation & Deodorising: Applying antimicrobial sanitiser and deodoriser after cleaning.
- 9. Carpet Protection: Applying Scotchgard or similar protectants to repel spills and stains.
- 10. Final Grooming & Inspection: Brushing carpet pile and checking results.
- 11. Rug and Mat Cleaning: Cleaning of area rugs and hallway runners using appropriate methods.
